Script for HSVARC Weekly Net

I'll be taking check-ins at this time. When checking in, please give me your call phonetically as well as your name.

First those stations that are mobile, portable or can only stay a short time. Come now.

<<Acknowledge stations>> <<Go through the check-in list asking each station to comment if they wish>>

Now, all other stations, please check in.

<<Acknowledge stations and repeat until silence>>

We will now ask each station that has checked in to say a few words if they would like. It is an opportunity to share anything that may be of interest to the group.

<<Go through the check-in list asking each station to say a few words>>

<<Check for additional check-ins>>

<<Allow late check-ins to say a few words>>

<<Ask if there is any further business for the net>>

Since there is no further business this is **<<your call>>** closing the net at **<<current time>>**. We had **<<count >>** check-ins to the net this evening. Thanks to everyone and good evening.
